1. Acting as a student host is an important service to Virginia Tech and the athletics department.. Appropriate conduct is required of you by Virginia Tech, the Atlantic Coast Conference, and NCAA standards. Remember, you are an AMBASSADOR of our athletics department family! Your actions should reflect positively on the department and Virginia Tech.
2. A maximum of \$40 per day may be provided to cover the entertainment expenses of yourself (and all hosts), the prospect, and the prospect's parents, legal guardians or spouse. You may be provided with an additional \$20 per day for each additional prospect entertained by you.
3. You must handle the money personally and not give it directly to the prospect. You cannot use the money to buy a hat, t-shirt, or any kind of souvenir. You cannot arrange for the prospect to receive a discount on merchandise at a sporting goods store or o ther place of business. **No cash may be given to the prospect.**
4. Boosters of Virginia Tech (contributors, fans, alumni) are not allowed to be involved in recruiting a prospect. If during the Official Visit, you and the prospect come in contact with a booster, the conversation must be limited to the exchange of greetings and ended as quickly as possible.
5. You may not transport the prospect or anyone accompanying the prospect more than 30 miles from campus.
6. **IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS A STUDENT HOST, PLEASE DON'T HESITATE TO CONTACT YOUR COACH!**

The following activities are NOT PERMITTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES:

- The use of alcohol.
- The use of drugs.
- The use of sex as a recruiting tool.
- Gambling or gaming activities.
- Any activity that violates criminal law.
- Use of a vehicle provided by coaches, student-athletes, boosters and/or anyone affiliated with Virginia Tech (students, students' parents, faculty, etc.)

I understand that failure to follow these guidelines could result in my dismissal from the team, and/or suspension from the university.
